Jeremy Wulff received his BSc from the University of Victoria, and then completed a PhD with Thomas Back (University of Calgary) and a postdoc with Andrew Myers (Harvard University) before returning to UVic in 2007 to begin his independent research career. Dr. Wulff was promoted to associate professor with tenure in 2013, and full professor in 2018. His research contributions—which range from synthetic methodology and complex molecule synthesis through to medicinal chemistry, chemical biology, automotive plastics, and polymer crosslinking—have been recognized with a Canada Research Chair (Tier II) from 2012–2022, and a Michael Smith Foundation for Health Research Career Scholar Award from 2011–2019. In 2020, he received the UVic Faculty of Science Research Excellence Award. He is currently on a 12 month sabbatical from UVic, during which he is appointed as a visiting professor at the University of Bath.
