Professor Renata Jastrząb is a distinguished chemist at Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań, Poland, where she serves as the Head of the Department of Coordination Chemistry within the Faculty of Chemistry. She earned her Master of Science degree in 1995, followed by a Doctorate in 2000, and achieved her Doctor Habilitatus in 2012. In 2023, she was appointed as a Professor.

For eight years, Professor Jastrząb held the position of Vice-Dean for Student Affairs at the Faculty of Chemistry. Additionally, she leads the Laboratory of chemistry teaching and contacts with the social environment and is an active member of the Polish Chemical Society.

Her research primarily focuses on coordination chemistry, nanomaterials, and spectroscopy. Notably, she has contributed significantly to the understanding of lanthanide Schiff base complexes and their applications in cancer diagnosis, therapy, and antibacterial activity.

Professor Jastrząb has also served as the editor for four special issues of the prestigious journal *Coordination Chemistry Reviews*, including "The Female Stars of Coordination Chemistry."

Throughout her career, Professor Jastrząb has collaborated with numerous researchers and has an extensive list of publications, reflecting her dedication to advancing the field of chemistry.
